YOUTH LEADER

Overview

First Baptist Church of Pawtucket is a multi-generational and multi-cultural community of faith that is welcoming, loving, and always growing. We strive to follow the teachings and example of Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior. We provide lively Sunday worship experiences, interactive and relevant Bible Studies, and Spirit-filled times of prayer and fellowship. We seek to help our community deepen its understanding of faith and life so that each individual may realize his or her full potential.

First Baptist Church is currently seeking a part-time Youth Leader to help advance the ministry of our church to young people (ages 13-18). This individual will provide 250 hours of service yearly.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

1. Coordinate and Lead Youth Activities (200 hours annually or 20 per month)

The Youth Leader will identify and coordinate, with input from our youth, one activity per month that engages FBC teens in community service, leadership development, or a social endeavor that deepens their spiritual formation and/or strengthens their relationship with one another. These activities may last 1-3 hours and take place on Sunday afternoons, Friday evenings, or Saturdays between September and June. The Youth Leader will be responsible for supervising youth during the activities and providing transportation to and from them, if held at a location outside of the church that is beyond a reasonable walking distance.

2. Coordinate Vacation Bible School (50 hours annually or average of 10 per month)

The Youth Leader will oversee the planning of a Vacation Bible School (VBS) targeting children and youth of FBC and its surrounding community. The VBS program will be held on a Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday evening in July or August. S/he will work with volunteers from First Baptist Church and its neighborhood between February and June to coordinate, advertise and carry out the program.
